


# What do I want my students to learn?

- ✓ Remember, the attention span of children is 7-10 minutes MAX
- **√"Chunk"** your lessons into smaller parts
  - √ incorporate an active learning element into each chunk
- ✓ This will allow you to check for understanding much more frequently

# How will I know they learned it?

- ✓ Collect it, "Check it off"

  ✓ Holding students accountable
- ✓Quick Google form, Pear Deck, Post-its, White boards (can also be paper they hold up), "Stop"/"Go" signs =(yes/no)
